



HEALTH & SAFETY REIMBURSEMENT FOR FRESNO COUNTY CC PROVIDERS

Funded by the California Department of Social Services

From **July 01, 2025, through June 01, 2026, or until funding runs out, whichever comes first**, the State of California will continue to make *Health & Safety* reimbursements available for **up to \$140.00**. The *Health and Safety* reimbursement funds are used to assist the following individuals in completing prescribed training on preventative health practices per AB243:

- ✓ Family Child Care Providers and 2 assistants ONLY (18 years and older)
- ✓ Child Care Centers (up to 8 staff ONLY)
- ✓ License-Exempt Child Care Providers and In-Home Providers

RULES AND LIMITATIONS:

1. Each eligible participant may receive up to \$140.00 per fiscal year for completed classes.
2. Under no circumstances shall the reimbursement exceed the actual costs incurred.
3. Training on preventative health practice (CPR/FA & Health and Safety) must be completed and paid between **July 1, 2025, through June 06, 2026**, and meet the mandated requirements. *Please reference page 2 of this form for policies and procedures regarding approved certification.*
4. Pediatric CPR/FA and Health and Safety Trainings must each be 8-hour trainings.
5. **There are no guarantees that you will be reimbursed. Reimbursements are contingent upon the availability of funds and are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.**

SUBMIT AND COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:

1. COPY of the front and back of issued card clearly displaying the EMSA stickers, unless CPR/FA certification was received from the American Red Cross or American Heart Association.
2. COPY of ORIGINAL RECEIPT clearly identifying your name/Center, the amount paid, and method of payment.

FAMILY CHILD CARE HOMES***Manual of Policies and Procedures - CCL - Family Child Care Homes - Title 22, Division 12, Chapter 3***

Health and Safety Code Section 1596.866 provides in part:

- (a)(1) In addition to other required training... each family day care home licensee who provides care, shall have at least 15 hours of health and safety training, and if applicable, at least one additional hour of training pursuant to clause (ii) of subparagraph (C) of paragraph (2).
- (2) The training shall include the following components:
 - (A) Pediatric first aid.
 - (B) Pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).
 - (C)(i) A preventive health practices course or courses that include instruction in the recognition, management, and prevention of infectious diseases, including immunizations, and prevention of childhood injuries.
 - (ii) For licenses issued on or after January 1, 2016...each family child day care licensee who provides care, shall have at least one hour of childhood nutrition training as part of the preventive health practices course or courses.
- (3) The training may include instruction in sanitary food handling, emergency preparedness and evacuation, and caring for children with special needs....

CHILDCARE CENTERS***Manual of Policies and Procedures - CCL - Child Care Center - Title 22, Division 12, Chapter 1, Art 3***

Health and Safety Code Section 1596.866 provides in pertinent part:

- (a)(1) In addition to any other required training, at least one director or teacher at each day care center ... shall have at least 15 hours of practice health and safety training, and if applicable, at least one additional hour of training pursuant to clause (ii) of subparagraph (C) of paragraph (2).
- (2) The training shall include the following components:
 - (A) Pediatric first aid.
 - (B) Pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR),
 - (C)(i) A preventative health practices course or courses that include instruction in the recognition, management, and prevention of infectious diseases, including immunizations, and prevention of childhood injuries.
 - (ii) For licenses issued on or after January 1, 2016, at least one director or teacher at each day care center...shall have at least one hour of childhood nutrition training as part of the preventive health practices course or courses.
- (3) The training may include instruction in sanitary food handling, emergency preparedness and evacuation, and caring for children with special needs.
- (b) Day care center directors... shall ensure that at least one staff member who has a current course completion card in pediatric first aid and pediatric CPR issued by the American Red Cross, or the American Heart Association, or by a training program that has been approved by the Emergency Medical Services Authority pursuant to this section and Section 1797.191 shall be onsite at all times when children are present at the facility, and shall be present with the children when children are offsite of the facility for facility activities....
